Haven and Virginia Smith Scholarship

Due to Mrs. Spencer by April 18, 2024

- 1. Recipients MUST attend a college, university, community college or trade school within the state of Nebraska.
- 2. The scholarship money can only be used for tuition and books and is made payable to the college, university, community college, or trade school that the recipient attends. No funds will be given directly to the recipient.
- 3. Alternates will be selected and any funds not used by the original recipients will be awarded to the alternates.
- 4. The scholarship is nonrenewable. No amount of scholarship funds can be carried forward to another school year.
- 5. One-half of the scholarship will be forwarded to the Financial Aid Office or Registrar's Office of the school that the student is attending in August of the year following graduation from high school, with the balance of the scholarship money forwarded in December of that same school year.

Application must include:

- 1. The Haven and Virginia Smith Scholarship application form filled out and printed.
- A personal letter of application that you have written to help the scholarship committee get to know you. Include your goals and expectations for the future, any obstacles you've encountered and possibly overcome, and any special circumstances that you would like to provide for the committee.
- 3. A resume regarding your academic information, extracurricular activities, community activities and volunteer work experience.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation from adults that can support your application in sealed envelopes. The adults providing letters of recommendation may not be parents or relatives of the applicant.
