Award

- **\$1000 Annual Scholarship Award to a Paxton graduate.**
- **A Scholarship Committee shall review the applications based on the stated criteria and select the recipient and alternate. Committee members shall excuse themselves from the selection process if a conflict of interest arises.**
- **The recipient will be announced at Paxton High School graduation ceremonies.**
- **The scholarship will be paid to the post-secondary institution of the student's choice upon proof of enrollment.**

Eligibility

- **The applicant must be a Paxton High School senior.**
- **The applicant must have a "C" or higher grade point average.**
- **The applicant must intend to enroll in post-secondary education, which may include any college, university, community college, trade school or other similar institution.**

Criteria

- **Academic achievement**
- **Leadership and community service**
- **Future career and educational goals**
- **Presentation of the application**
- **Essay**
- **Interview (To be held at the school in April)**

Application

- **Complete the application form. Include an essay.**
- **Attach a transcript of your high school grades, which includes your GPA and a resume.**

- **Applicants will be asked for a personal interview. The committee will notify all applicants of the interview schedule.**
- **Give your completed application to the Paxton Schools' School Counselor:**
- **All materials must be completed and turned in by April 18, 2024. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**
